

## Discovery Dressing Rooms

The Discovery has a total of 11 dressing rooms. Two rooms located on the ground floor next to stage left and nine rooms located in the basement under the stage. All downstairs dressing rooms have makeup counters with mirrors, chairs, wastebaskets, and incandescent lighting. All dressing rooms have a paging system with stage audio feed. This makes a total of 81 make-up stations.

Room's 189, 190, 191, 192 and 193 are dressing rooms for two to four people with a shower, sink, and restroom. These rooms are located downstairs below the Discovery Stage.

Rooms 185 and 194 are eight person dressing rooms with a shower, sink, and restroom. These rooms are located downstairs below the Discovery Stage.

Room 181 is a twelve-person dressing room with a shower, sink, and restroom. This room is located downstairs below the Discovery Stage.

Room 186 is an eighteen-person dressing room with two showers, sink, and restrooms. This room is located downstairs below the Discovery Stage.

Room 261 is a six-person dressing room with a sink. **It does not have a restroom.** This room is located on ground level 30 feet from stage left door.

Room 263 is a nine-person dressing room with a sink. **It does not have a restroom.** This room is located on ground level 30 feet from stage left door.

Additional Dressing Rooms may be available with an additional cleaning fee charge to the User. Request must be made with a two-week advance notice in order to schedule additional dressing rooms if available.

A Wardrobe room with two washers and two dryers is located in the basement sharing the hallway with dressing rooms. The wardrobe room contains steamers, sewing machines, and an industrial sink. Client must supply their own cleaning and repair supplies. Rolling costume racks are available but a limited number exist and are assigned on first come first serve basis. The Sydney Laurence and Discovery Theatre share the same wardrobe room.

An Actor's Lounge is located in the basement. The lounge contains a refrigerator, microwave oven, coffee makers, cabinets, one love seat, chairs, table, and a video monitor with stage feed. Refrigerator and cabinets can be locked but client must provide the pad locks. The paging system can be heard in this room. The lounge has a phone that has local outside access. It may be used for long distance with a phone card. Additional phone and /or fax lines can be added with a two-week notice and additional charge.

A Production office is located in the dressing room hallway on the basement floor. The office is a one-person room with one desk and two chairs. The room has a phone that has local outside access. It may be used for long distance with a phone card. Additional phone and /or fax lines can be added with a two-week notice and additional charge. All rooms in the basement can be easily access by a freight elevator.

All dressing room hallways must be kept clear for fire egress established by local fire codes. The Anchorage Fire Marshall must approve any storage of road boxes in corridors.

Catering is allowed in the dressing rooms and lounge. A license caterer must serve all alcohol. The client is responsible for cleaning dressing room areas.
